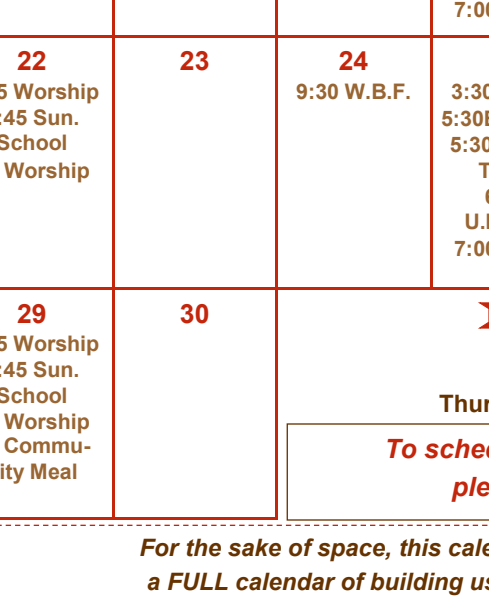
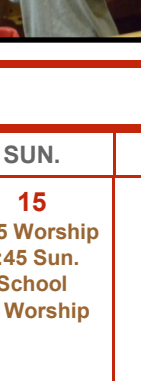

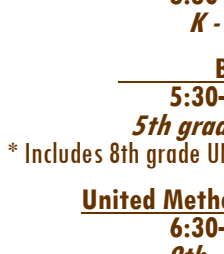

Spotlight on Faith

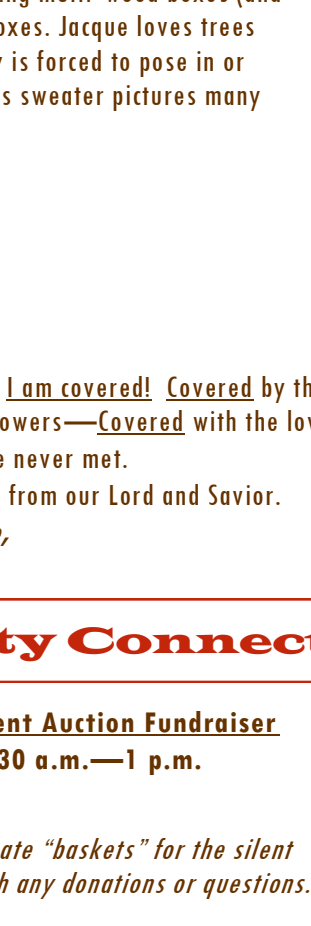
