Mother's Day

The modern American holiday of Mother's Day was first celebrated in 1908, when Anna Jarvis held a memorial for her mother in Grafton, West Virginia. Her campaign to make "Mother's Day" a recognized holiday in the United States began in 1905, the year her beloved mother, Ann Reeves Jarvis, died. Anna's mission was to honor her own mother and to set aside a day to honor mothers, "the person who has done more for you than anyone in the world".

Due to the campaign efforts of Anna Jarvis, several states officially recognized the first Mother's Day, 1910. In 1914 Woodrow Wilson signed the proclamation creating Mother's Day, and designating the second Sunday in May, as a national holiday to honor mothers and those who fill a maternal role in one's life.

Maintain a healthy weight. If you are overweight or obese, you should try to lose weight. Weight loss can reduce stress on weight-bearing joints, limit further injury, increase mobility, and reduce the risk of associat-

ed health problems. A dietitian can help you develop healthy eating habits. A healthy diet and regular exercise can help reduce weight.

Avoid injury. Putting too much stress on a joint that has been repeatedly injured may lead to the development of osteoarthritis.
