## SPOTLIGHT ON FAITH

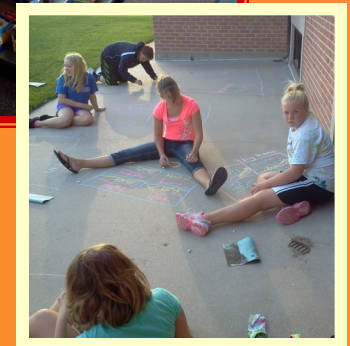
Mary and Le Garrison were married in 1982 at First United Methodist Church in Kearney. They had met at the church while attending a divorce seminar. They were married for 24 years before Le died of cancer in 2007. Le had played the tuba in many bands from the time he was 16 years old, and he sang with the church choir and the Kearney Area Barbershop Chorus. Mary and Le joined Faith United Methodist Church when C.J. Willis was the pastor.

Mary grew up in Grand Island and graduated from Grand Island Senior High School. She attended Kearney State College but dropped out after one year. Mary then worked in Wisconsin, Lincoln, and Denver. After five years of working, she returned to college in Lincoln and graduated from the University of Nebraska at Lincoln. Mary then taught in Lincoln and Rapid City, South Dakota. When her ex-husband lost his teaching job in Rapid city, they moved to Kearney in 1974. Mary began working for the Buffalo County Department of Welfare which became the Nebraska Department of Social Services, which in turn became the Department of Health and Human Services. She worked first as a caseworker and then as a supervisor and retired after 25 years of service. During her employment, she served on the first Kearney Homeless Coalition that began in 1994 after the Kearney Ministerial Association had done a homeless survey. She also was on the first Residential Assistance to Families Transition Board of Directors that purchased the RAFT House on Avenue N.

After retiring, Mary has had many volunteer jobs including the library, Kearney Public Schools, Mid-Nebraska Community Services, and the Kearney Police Records Department. She currently volunteers at Good Samaritan Hospital. She belongs to the Golden K Kiwanis Club, has served as president and is currently on several committees.

Mary has been the church treasurer, served on several church committees, and is currently chair of the Memorial Committee. She attends the Breakfast Club Sunday School class and belongs to the Tuesday morning Women's Bible Study class.

Her main hobby is genealogy, and she belongs to the Fort Kearney Genealogical Society. She has been researching her family history for over 25 years. And she still has a long ways to go!
