For the last several years, the church has been operating with a negative balance. We have always been able to pay our bills but have always ended in the red. The Finance Committee has done a great job, along with all Faith committees of holding expenditures down this year. We have tried to pay our Mission Shares monthly and have done fairly well. At our last meeting, Sandy reported we had paid \$20,247 (through August) of our \$36,743 obligation. We hope to pay \$12,247 through December which will leave us short \$4249 of achieving our goal of paying all of our Mission Shares for 2011.

During the Capital Fund drive, we were pleased Faith members continued to give to the general fund as well as raise so much money for the Capital Fund. We operated the Buffalo County Fair concession stand thanks to so many wonderful volunteers and raised \$5,829. Art in the Park concession stand brought in \$1467. We have another garage sale scheduled for Oct. 23rd with proceeds going to the general fund. While our income has exceeded our expenses, we are still not out of the red. However, we are closer to being in the black, at his time, than we were last year.
